Please make your check payable to Lorie Abbott and enclose with your entry. Parking of RVs and regular vehicles will be allowed near the rings by permit only. Please do not block the fire lanes.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- After closing bitches in season receive refund of amount paid less \$10 per day.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No refund for duplicate entry or entry in class that is not offered i.e. FAST or T2B on days not offered.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$7 processing fee.
- Refunds are mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE EENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Failure to follow the instructions of the Show Committee or their Agent will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple Quintuple or Sextuple Q will be offered a corresponding pin. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a bar and special rosette. Note in the T2B class only first place in each height is awarded.

Course Familiarization / Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Sunday move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Saturday.

Wait List: NORCAL Golden Retrievers, Inc. are offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 pm on September 15, 2016. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on September 28, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be issued and mailed in the time frame of 7 days before to 7 days following the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on September 28, 2016 will receive a FULL REFUND.
