Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing.

Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday September 26, 2016.

Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday and/or Monday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of on Saturday / Sunday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master / Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in will begin at 7:30 am each day.

Handlers are not required to check in at these times but should plan to arrive early enough for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 8:00 am each morning.

All classes *except* Master/ Excellent Standard and JWW: all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 3 pm on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew.

No Set Ups in the Pavilions or on the Beer Tree Lawn.

RV Parking Check in with Kurt Maccauley upon arrival. All overnight spaces are assigned. Those on the set up list may begin arriving at noon on Friday. All others may begin arriving at 2:00 pm.

Daily Parking and Unloading

Volunteers and those with parking passes need to enter through the Yellow Gate.

Unloading near the main lawn is allowed each day. All vehicles must then move to the designated parking lot. A daily parking fee of \$6 will be charged.

Food Trucks

A variety of food trucks will be onsite beginning Saturday morning.

There is a Raley's Supermarket walking distance from the rings.

Morning Hospitality

Coffee and light snacks will be available each morning.

Critical Workers will receive lunch.

Rings

The rings will be outside on grass and will measure approximately 100' x 100'. Exhibitors should bring their own shade.

Travel Directions:

From Hwy 50

Take the Forni Rd. exit toward Placerville Dr. Fairgrounds will be approximately 1/4 mile on the right.

BLUE GATE—RVs enter through this gate which will be open all day and night. It *might* be dummy locked at night

GREEN GATE—pedestrian gate going into the Plaza. Will be locked at 10 pm

YELLOW GATE—Open at 6 am. Locked at 9 pm

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height

card **must** be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of

dogs will take place near the score table throughout the day when Cindy Macklin is not otherwise occupied. Measurement will "count" toward height cards.

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW Walk Split

If you think you will have a conflict due to working or running in another ring then walk with an earlier group. If walking with an earlier group you may NOT walk again with your group.

Saturday and Sunday

There will be three walk groups:

Group One: 4—16

Group Two: 20 Master Regular

Group Three: 20 Excellent Regular, All 24, All 20 Preferred

Monday

There will be two walk groups:

Group One: 20 Master Regular

Group Two: 20 Excellent Regular, All 24 and All Preferred

If the Classes “Jam”

We have attempted to create a schedule without conflicts. Having said that when planning the schedule there are multiple unknown variables such as: number of obstacles on each course, course needs to be adjusted around a surface hazard, the course lends to a long handler lead out, a dog soils the ring etc. If the rings “Jam Up” with the same height walking or competing in both rings at the same time then one ring will be held. You WILL get your walk and run. Don't stress.

ABBA Dogs will give each worker, not entered in the event, a raffle ticket for each class worked. Dry erase boards will be located near each ring. If you see a blank space and have free time just write your name in the blank.

Course Maps

Once the Judges arrive at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. T2B maps will be clear file box. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please do not take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy. Lastly, DO NOT remove the map posted in the notebooks.

Saturday, Sunday & Monday

Check in begins at 7:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 8:00 am.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes.

Where Are The Ribbons



Once the Judge has signed off on the scores the ribbon labels will be printed and placed in the clipboard on the Awards Table. There will be a check off sheet on the top of the clipboard indicating which classes have been signed off and labels printed. You may take your ribbon if

the label has been printed.

Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin.

No awards will be mailed.

Score books will be located on the main score table.
