Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs earning a qualifying score. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. Dogs earning a title will receive a special ribbon. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will be awarded a special corresponding pin. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special rosette and bar.

Judging will begin:

Friday noon **Saturday 8:30 am** **Sunday 8:30 am**

Trial Hours: One hour before judging begins until one half hour after completion of judging.

Worker Raffle

Saturday and Sunday there will be a worker raffle. Each volunteer will receive raffle tickets for each class worked. Those working all day will receive lunch.

NQ Raffle!

Open to all exhibitors. It's another chance to win, even if you mess up on course. If your dog NQs a run, come fill out a raffle ticket for a chance to win prizes.

Wait List

Fresno DTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to midnight on October 20, 2016. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on November 2, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be issued and mailed in the time frame of 7 days before to 7 days following the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on November 2, 2016 will receive a FULL REFUND.

Classes Offered

Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent/Master Standard, JWW FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent/Master for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Premier Standard & JWW on Friday.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers or are listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- After closing bitches in season will receive refund of amount paid less \$10 per day t.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$7 processing fee.
- Refunds are mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- No Refund for duplicate entries or entry into class not offered i.e. Novice and Open on Friday, FAST on Sunday.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Dogs under four months of age are not allowed at AKC events.
- **NO LOOSE DOGS AT ANY TIME IN THE RV AREA**

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Saturday and Sunday move ups will be allowed provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last dog has crossed the finish line on Friday/ Saturday.

Pairs Relay—Saturday November 5, 2016

Entry fee \$5/dog for a total of \$10 per team

Class will run at end of the day

Pre-Registration encouraged by mail received through November 1st. After November 1st register at the main score table before 2 pm on Saturday, November 5, 2016.

Dogs/Exhibitors are not required to be entered in the licensed show to enter Pairs Relay however, both exhibitor and dog must be in good standing with AKC and sign a entry form.

Course Description: The course will include obstacles used on a Regular Standard course with the exception of weave poles and table—which will not be used. Each dog/handler will run a portion of the course as defined by the Judge. A baton will be carried by the “active” handler. There will be a defined area for the baton handoff. The Teams will come into the ring on lead. Only the active dog will be off lease. Once the first dog has finished it’s course and is in the handoff area the dog is restrained. The baton is given to the second handler and that dog may now start. Dogs will leave the ring on lead.

Team Description: Each Team will include two separate dogs and two separate handlers. Teams can be made up of dogs from any level and any jump height. Mixed Pairs are welcome. Exhibitors are encouraged to name their Team and dress in Team attire. A dog may be on two teams with two different dogs, however they must run a different side of the course with each Team.



Scoring: Time plus Faults. The Team with the fastest time will be the first place team. Next fastest time will be second and so forth. With each standard fault a dog makes 5 seconds will be added to the Team’s total time. Dropped bars, missed contacts, teeter fly offs and off courses are all scored as 5 second faults. Refusals and run outs will not be judged.

Compensation will be given to these specified jump heights: 8” and 12” dogs will be given a 4 second handicap. 16” dogs will be given a 2 second handicap. Preferred dogs will be given a 1 second handicap. Example: a Team with a 20” dog and a 12” dog will have 4 second subtracted rom their total course time. A Team with a 12” and a 16” dog will have 6 seconds deducted.

Awards: Each dog/handler on a Team that places will be awarded a dog toy with the 1st place Team getting first choice and so forth. Placement will be awarded out to 6th place.
