Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, March 27, 2016. Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday and / or Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Friday / Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master/Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the

regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in begins at:

Friday: 9:00 am
Saturday & Sunday
7:00 am

Exhibitors are not required to check at these times but should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and measurement of dog if necessary.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 9:30 am on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday and All classes *except* Master/Excellent Standard and JWW: all heights will walk together before judging of their class.

Set up crew: please arrive 7 am on Friday.

Stake out your area then help set up rings and equipment.

General crating for those not willing to help with set up is 8:30 am. .

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SET UP BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TIME.

We must stick to the times stipulated in the site contract. **We** the Show Committee.

NO PARKING FEE THIS WEEKEND!

The Club has paid your parking fee. It will not be necessary to purchase daily parking passes from the college.

Directions: From US 101 (North or South) take Yerba Buena Exit. Turn LEFT (East) onto Yerba Buena. Continue East on Yerba Buena about 3 miles past San Felipe Road (shopping center on left with Wells Fargo, Starbucks). Turn left at first driveway, just past large, empty field into Parking Lot 9. Show site is in front and to the right.



All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured

prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table throughout the

day when Kathie Leggett, Cindy Macklin and Candy Gaiser are not otherwise occupied.

Course Maps

Once the Judge arrives at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. The T2B maps will be in a separate container. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please DO NOT take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy.

To receive prime crating space under cover volunteer to set up the rings and equipment at 7 am on Friday.

Travel 0.09 miles.

I'm Hungry and Thirsty

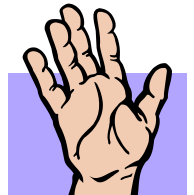

So, When Should I Arrive

Saturday and Sunday

Check in begins at 7:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 8:00 am in the Standard ring.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes—except FAST to Premier Standard which may take longer.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes per group.

Doing The Math

Using Saturday as an example:

Master JWW is the fourth class to be judged.

Master FAST 33 dogs = 33 min

Premier JWW 21 dogs = 21 min

Course Build to Premier Standard 15 min

Course Walk = 13 min

Premier Standard = 23 dogs = 35 min

Course Build to Master JWW = 10 min

My best guess is the first walk for Master JWW will be 127 minutes after 8:00 am or *around 10:00*. This is a guess and not a promise.

Master JWW is expected to take 93 minutes plus two walks of 13 min each.

It is expected judging will finish at approximately 5:30.
