**Wait List:** Sacramento Valley Weimaraner Club is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials' closing date/time. A maximum of 100 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to midnight on July 1, 2016. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm on July 13, 2016 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a refund will be issued and mailed in the time frame of 7 days before to 7 days following the event. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm on July 13, 2016 will receive a FULL REFUND.

## Volunteer Services

## Notice to Exhibitors

- This event is open to all AKC registered dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP / PAL numbers or are listed in the AKC Canine Partner Program, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- After closing day bitches in season will receive refund less \$10 per day processing fee.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$7 processing fee.
- No refund for duplicate entries.
- No refund for entry in class not offered on that particular day i.e. FAST on Sunday.
- All refunds will be mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

## Class Information, Jump Heights, Scoring

**Classes offered:** Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent and Masters for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent and Masters for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class and height. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org). For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 851 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste. 100., Raleigh, NC 27616-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

## Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

## Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

## Trial Site—Evergreen Valley College

The trial will be held outdoors on grass. No other food will be available for purchase.

### Directions:

From US 101 (North or South) take Yerba Buena Exit. Turn LEFT (East) onto Yerba Buena. Continue East on Yerba Buena about 3 miles past San Felipe Road (shopping center on left with Wells Fargo, Starbucks). Turn left at first driveway, just past large, empty field into Parking Lot 9. Show site is in front and to the right.
