## Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

### Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received, or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, July 11, 2016. Absolutely no move ups for Saturday will be allowed after this date and time. Move ups for Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master/Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master

running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

All Classes *except*

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW: all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

See page four for Master/Excellent Standard and JWW walk through directions. The order will be walk/run, walk/run etc. Each group will walk immediately before they run.

### Saturday to Sunday Move Up

The Pink move up forms are located on a clip board at the score table.

Step 1: Complete the form

Step 2: Place in the black plastic basket used to collect scribe sheets

### Directions:

From US 101 (North or South) take Yerba Buena Exit. Turn LEFT (East) onto Yerba Buena. Continue East on Yerba Buena about 3 miles past San Felipe Road (shopping center on left with Wells Fargo, Starbucks). Turn left at first driveway, just past large, empty field into Parking Lot 9. Show site is in front and to the right.

## All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height that do not have an AKC height card or who have not been measured for a card must be measured BEFORE their first run of the weekend. Measurement of dogs without height cards

will take place near the main score table throughout the day when Kathie Leggett and Terry LeClair are not otherwise occupied. Fill out the NCR form before measurement. Forms will be located near the measurement table and

the main score table. Once form is completed come to the main score table and tell Lorie or Pam who will then locate a measuring official.

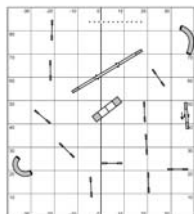

## Course Maps

Once the Judge arrives at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. The T2B maps will be in a separate container. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please DO NOT take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy.

Take the Santa Teresa Boulevard/CA-87 N exit, EXIT 5B.

Travel 0.27 miles. Turn left onto Santa Teresa Blvd.

Travel 0.27 miles. Turn right onto Thornwood Dr.

Travel 0.09 miles.

5440 Thornwood Dr, San Jose, CA 95123-1214, 5440 THORNWOOD DR is on the right.

If you reach Winfield Blvd you've gone about 0.3 miles too far

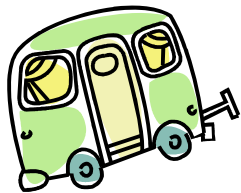

## I'm Hungry and Thirsty

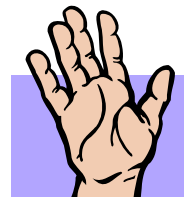

**So, When Should I Arrive**

**Saturday and Sunday**

Check in begins at 7:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 8:00 am in the Standard ring.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes—except FAST to Premier Standard which may take longer.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes per group.

**Doing The Math**

Using Saturday as an example:

Master JWW is the fourth class to be judged.

Master FAST 33 dogs = 33 min

Premier JWW 21 dogs = 21 min

Course Build to Premier Standard 15 min

Course Walk = 13 min

Premier Standard = 23 dogs = 35 min

Course Build to Master JWW = 10 min

My best guess is the first walk for Master JWW will be 127 minutes after 8:00 am or around 10:00. This is a guess and not a promise.

Master JWW is expected to take 93 minutes plus two walks of 13 min each.

It is expected judging will finish at approximately 5:30.
