## Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

### Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received, or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Wednesday, September 21, 2016. Absolutely no move ups for Monday will be allowed after this time and date. Trial to Trial move ups must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Monday. See additional instructions on page 2.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Excellent & Master Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the

regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

**Set Ups** No exhibitor set ups before 3 pm on Sunday unless you are part of the set up crew. There is plenty of space in the grandstands for shaded crating. Exhibitors can set up shade near the stables. Bring a chair.

### Food and beverages

Exhibitors should order lunch through the Store. There are many fast food restaurants near the fairgrounds.

**Check in** will begin at 7 am each day.

**Judging** will begin at 8 am each day.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has

approved the course. This will be at approximately 7:30 am. All heights will walk together before judging of the class begins.

## All About the Height Cards

All dogs, jumping lower than 24" in regular classes and lower than 20" in preferred classes, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height

card must be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table *throughout* the

day when Tammy Domico is not otherwise occupied. Measurement will count toward height cards.

If you need to be measured come to score table and ask for Dave or Lorie.

### Trial to Trial Move Ups

The Pink move up forms are located on a clip board at the score table.

Step 1: Complete the form

Step 2: Place in the black plastic basket used to collect scribe sheets

The score posting books and awards will be located near the main score table. If the ribbon labels are ready then the daily awards form, located on the front of the clipboard, will be initialed next to that class. All scores MUST be verified by the judge BEFORE ribbons can be released.

### Monday and Tuesday

Check in begins at 7:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 8:00 am in Ring 1.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes.
