Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing.

Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday November 21, 2016. Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups Saturday and Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of on Friday or Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master / Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed

separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in will begin

Friday: 9 am

Saturday 8 am

Sunday 7 am

Handlers are not required to check in at these times but should plan to arrive early enough for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 30 minutes before start time of first class in each ring.

All Classes *except* Master/Excellent Standard and JWW: All heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into four walk groups:

1. Dogs Jumping 4-12
2. Dogs Jumping 16
3. Master Regular 20 dogs
4. Excellent 20, Preferred 20 and 24 dogs

Rings—The rings will be on dirt, under cover and will measure approximately 90' x 90'. Both rings will be in Arena 3. All crating will be in Arena 4. See MEC map.

No set ups before 9 am on Friday.

Directions:

From Sacramento/Bay Area: Take Hwy 50 east towards Lake Tahoe. Exit at Sunrise Blvd. Turn right off the exit ramp and proceed for 7.4 miles to Jackson Rd (Hwy 16). Turn left on Jackson Road and proceed 7.1 miles to Lone Pine Rd., Turn right on Lone Pine. Murieta Equine Complex is immediately on your right.

From Reno: Take Hwy 80 towards Sacramento. Exit at Sierra College Blvd. Turn South. After a few miles, Sierra College Blvd becomes Hazel Ave. Follow Hazel Blvd to Hwy 50 West. Exit Hwy 50 at Sunrise Blvd. Turn left off the exit ramp and follow directions above.



All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card **must** be measured

prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table throughout the

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW Walk Split

If you think you will have a conflict due to working or running in another ring then walk with an earlier group. If walking with an earlier group you may NOT walk again with your group.

There will be four walk groups:

Group One: 4 8 12

Group Two: 16

Group Three: 20 Master Regular

Group Four: 20 Excellent Regular, 20 Preferred, 24

If the Classes “Jam”

We have attempted to create a schedule without conflicts. Having said that when planning the schedule there are multiple unknown variables such as: number of obstacles on each course, course needs to be adjusted around a surface hazard, the course lends to a long handler lead out, a dog soils the ring etc. If the rings “Jam Up” with the same height walking or competing in both rings at the same time then one ring will be held. You WILL get your walk and run. Don’t stress.

Where Are The Ribbons



The Awards Table will be located in Arena 4 with crating. Once the Judge has signed off on the scores the ribbon labels will be printed and placed in the clipboard on the Awards Table. There will be a check off sheet on the top of the clipboard indicating which classes have been signed off

and labels printed. You may take your ribbon if the label has been printed.

Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin.

No awards will be mailed.

Score books will be located on the ledge near the arena office.

Course Maps

Once the Judges arrive at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. T2B maps will be in the clear file box labeled T2B. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please do not take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy. Lastly, DO NOT remove the map posted in the notebooks.

Check in begins at 9:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 10:30 am in the JWW ring and 10:00 am in Standard.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes.

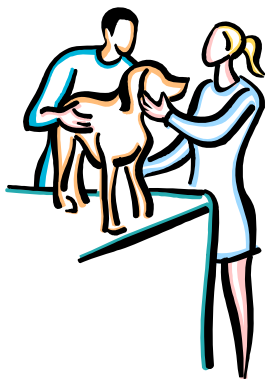
From MEC: Left on CA-16

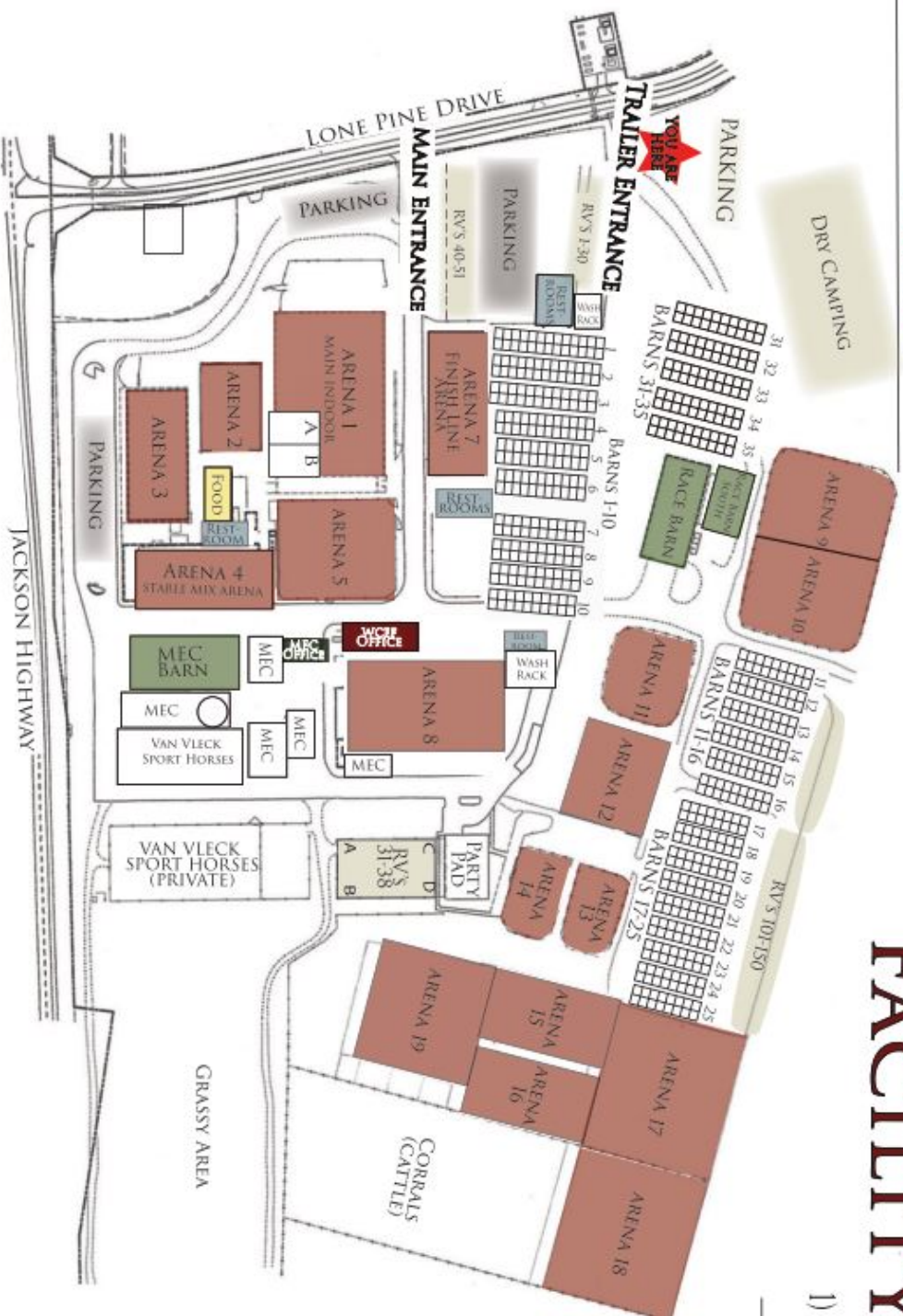
