scores. Special ribbons will be awarded to dogs earning a new title. Master dogs earning
a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q on the same day will receive a pin.
Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special rosette and bar. Prizes will be
awarded to 1st place in each class.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fees.
- After closing date bitches in season will refund will be amount paid less \$10 per day processing fee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No refund for duplicate entry or entry in class that is not offered ie FAST or T2B on days not offered.
- Withdrawal of entry before closing date will receive refund less \$7 processing fee.
- Refunds are mailed in the time frame of seven days before to seven days after the event.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETE, ACCURATE, AND LEGIBLE INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS; ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN THE TRIAL.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.
- Failure to follow the instructions of the Show Committee or their Agent will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in a Bench Committee Hearing.

Class Information, Jump Heights, Scoring

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent & Master for Standard, JWW and FAST. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent & Master for Standard, JWW and FAST. Regular and Preferred T2B. Regular and Preferred Premier Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class and height. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste., Raleigh, NC 27617-2028. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Course Familiarization/Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.
