Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running

order contingent on move-up entries not yet received, or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Exhibitors shall be provided armbands or stickers indicating their dog's running order number for this trial. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, June 20, 2016. Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this date and time. Move ups for Saturday and Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course of Friday or Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard/JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master/Excellent/Master Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master

running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in

Saturday and Sunday at 7:00 am.

Judging will begin

Friday at 11:00 am
Saturday and Sunday at 8:00 am

Each day judging will begin in the Standard ring and rotate to JWW ring after each class.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 10:30 am on Friday and 7:30 am on Saturday and

Sunday.

Open and Novice Standard and JWW, all levels of FAST and T2B: all heights will walk the course together prior to their class being judged.

See page three for Excellent/Master Standard and JWW walk through directions. The order will be walk/run, walk/run etc. Each group will walk immediately before they run.

Set Ups No exhibitor set up before 9 am on Friday unless you are part of the set up crew. Bring shade.

Rings will be on the main lawn. Ring size 100 x 100.

Directions:

East on I-80: East to Woodland off ramp (Hwy 113). Take Gibson Rd. Turn left. At Matmor signal turn right. Turn left onto Gum Ave. and proceed west to main entrance.

South on I-5: Exit at Hwy 113 (Main St.) Stay on 113 to Gibson Rd. Turn right at Matmor and go to Gum Ave. Turn left onto Gum and proceed to the main entrance.

North on I-5: Exit E. Main Hwy 113. Turn left and follow thru town. Turn left on East St. Go to Gum Ave. and turn left. Proceed to the front entrance of the fairgrounds.

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured

prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table throughout the

weekend when Cindy Macklin, Terry LeClair and Candy Gaisser are not otherwise occupied.

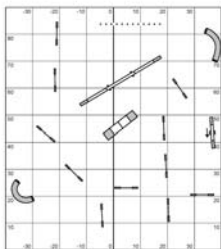

Course Maps

Once the Judge arrives at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the three black file boxes labeled either Master, Open or Novice. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please **DO NOT** take a map unless you are actually in that class.

Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy.



Lastly, **DO NOT** remove the map posted in the notebooks.

Directions: Take I-80 towards Sacramento. Take 113 north towards Woodland. Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison Drive. Turn right at the first stop light (LaRue Road). Follow LaRue Road to the first right turn (Garrod Drive). Follow Garrod Drive to the stop sign. After stopping, proceed directly ahead. The client parking lot entrance is on your right. Client parking is free as long as you park in a designated patient parking space. Client parking cannot accommodate vehicles that require more space than a passenger car. There are three different reception stations and it is important to come to the station mentioned when you made your appointment. Reception station 3 is in the building on your left as you drive toward the parking lot and reception stations 1 and 2 are in the main hospital building which is to the west of the parking lot. Drive time approximately 15 minutes.

Scores & Awards

The score posting books will be located near the main score table—this will be near Lorie's trailer and black truck. The ribbons and first place prizes will be located in the Club Area—this will be near the worker raffle. There will be a clipboard at the awards table. If the ribbon labels are ready the daily awards form, located on the front of the clipboard, will be initialed next to that class. All scores **MUST** be verified by the judge **BEFORE** ribbons can be released.

If you have any questions regarding your score ask the main score table: Lorie Abbott and Dave Connet. If we do not know the answer will find out. Please do not ask the Scribe or Timer your score or time. They are busy scoring the next dog.

Friday: 294 runs

Saturday: 323 runs

Sunday: 279 runs

Cindy Blanton will judge all classes

Judging will begin each day in the Standard Ring then rotate after each class to the JWW ring.

Be sure to check in *before* walking your course. The Scribe needs to verify the order of the scribe sheets for absent and conflict dogs.

Master/Excellent Walk Split

Dogs will be judged from the lowest armband number in each class to the highest armband number in each class.



Friday and Saturday: Premier Standard and T2B on Sunday will be open for walk through approximately 30 minutes before judging begins. All heights are expected to walk before judging begins. Once Premier Standard is finished there will be one timed walk for Premier JWW. All heights are expected to walk before judging begins.

Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Master / Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into two walk groups: 4/8/12/16 20/24/26

Order will be walk/run and walk/run.

The PINK move up forms are located on a clip board at the by the score posting books.

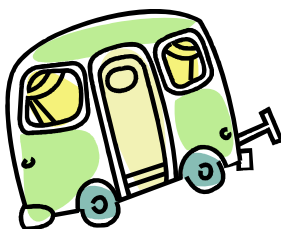
Step 1: Complete the form

Audio Books Library and Exchange (ABLE)

Our Goal: This free library is part of a public education campaign to raise awareness about the dangers of drowsy driving. Many drivers find that listening to audio books can be a great way to stay alert behind the wheel. Please visit www.livetorunagain.org for more information.

How the Library Works: Throughout the U.S. and Canada, volunteer ABLE librarians set up their libraries at dog events. Wherever ABLE is in attendance, you can “exchange” audio books you’ve listened to for others in the collection. **We ask that you borrow one or two at a time and return them within a month or so.** This allows us to help as many people as possible. You can return your materials to any LTRA library.

Our History: Live to Run Again was founded in honor of Jane Accampo Callaghy, a dog enthusiast who died on April 1, 2001, when the driver of her vehicle fell asleep on the way home from an agility trial. In Jane’s memory, we hope to make a difference so other drivers and their loved ones can avoid drowsy-driving accidents.

Saturday and Sunday

Check in begins at 7:00 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

Judging begins at 8:00 am in the Standard ring

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes.

Doing The Math

Using Saturday as an example:

Open Standard is after Premier Standard, Master/Excellent Standard, Premier JWW and Master/Excellent JWW.

Premier Standard 33 dogs = 49 min

Course Build Master Standard = 10 min

Course Walk = 13 min x 2 groups

Master Standard 82 dogs = 123 min

Premier JWW 32 dogs = 32 min

Course Build Master JWW = 10 min

Course Walk = 13 min x 2 groups

Master JWW = 51 dogs = 51 min

Course Build Open Standard = 10 min

My best guess is that Open Standard will begin judging 359 minutes after 8:00 am *around 2:00 pm*. Keep in mind the walk will be during judging of Master JWW and the timeline is a guess and not a promise.
