Set Ups, Check In, Start Times, Walk Through

Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, May 1, 2017. All move ups must be in writing. Absolutely no move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday and Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Friday or Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard, JWW, and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A.

Master/Excellent Standard, JWW and FAST classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent. The preferred classes will run intermingled with the regular classes by

height. Each class will be briefed separately. Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Check in:

Exhibitors are not required to check in at these times but should plan to arrive in time for their walk through and measurement of dog if necessary.

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course. This will be at approximately 11:30 am on Friday and 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday.

For all classes *except* Master/Excellent Standard and JWW there will be one walk for

all heights.

Master/Excellent Standard and JWW will be split into two walk groups.

Order will be Walk/Run and Walk/Run

FAST on Saturday:

All levels walk together.

Crating and Exhibitor

Set Ups No exhibitor set ups before 10 am unless you are on the set up committee. The rings will be outdoors on grass and measure 100' x 100'.

AM snacks and lunch provided for all volunteers each day.

Drinking water will be available—bring your own drinking vessel.

Continue East on Yerba Buena about 3 miles past San Felipe Road (shopping center on left with Wells Fargo, Starbucks). Turn left at first driveway, just past large, empty field into Parking Lot 9. Show site is in front and to the right.

All About the Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height

card must be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs

will take place near the score table throughout the day when Cindy Macklin and Kathie Leggett are not otherwise occupied.

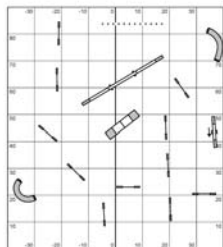

Course Maps

Once the Judge arrives at the show site hard copies of the course maps are placed in one of the two black file boxes labeled either Premier/Master and Open/Novice. A copy of each map is posted in the score posting notebooks. The file boxes and score posting notebooks are located at the score table. Copies of the course maps are based on entry numbers so please **DO NOT** take a map unless you are actually in that class. By taking a course map for a class of which you are not entered you are taking a map from another exhibitor.



Exhibitors should consider bringing with them to the show tracing paper and a pencil. If the maps are gone they can trace a map from the posted copy. Exhibitors also have the option of taking a photo of the map with their cell phone camera.



Scores & Awards

The score posting books will be located near the main score table. The ribbons and first place prizes will be located in the main club area. There will be a clipboard at the awards table. If the ribbon labels are ready then the daily awards form, located on the front of the clipboard, will be initialed next to that class. All scores **MUST** be verified by the judge **BEFORE** ribbons can be released.

Dry erase boards will be located near each ring. If you see a blank space and have free time just write your name in the blank. Get your raffle tickets from Karen & Mimi.

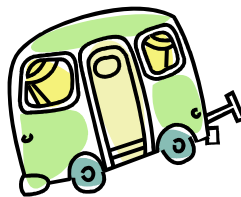

So, When Should I Arrive

Saturday and Sunday

Check in begins at 7:30 am. You are not required to check in at this time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and, if necessary, measurement of dog.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes—except FAST to Standard and back which may take longer.

For course walk calculate 13 minutes.
